



Year 1 Summary of Term's Work - Autumn 2025

<p>This term we will be learning all about:</p> <p>Counting and representing numbers</p> <p>Addition and subtraction</p> <p>2D Shapes</p> <p>Place Value</p> <p>Position and direction</p> <p>Addition and subtraction using money</p>	<p>We will continue to work in our coloured Read Write Inc groups to cover most of our English learning this term. In these lessons we will learn set 1 special friends and some set 2 sounds, use these sounds to read words and stories, spell using the sounds we know. We will begin to respond to the stories we have read through forming simple sentences and learning 'red words' (common exception words) such as I, no, go, to, me, my.</p>	<p>In Science we will be exploring seasonal changes and weather and children will name the four seasons in order and describe the typical weather in each and some activities and events in the four seasons. We will describe the appearance of a tree's leaves in each season. We will then explore everyday objects and identify the materials they are made from. Recognise that objects are made from materials that suit their purpose and recall that a property is how a material can be described.</p>	<p>In R.E we begin revisiting Creation and Covenant, we will hear the story of creation and reflect on how we can care for the gift God gave us and how God loves us. We will look at the Nicene Creed and share in school Mass. We will also look at our Monthly Values think about how these link to the Bible and our everyday lives. After half-term, we will learn about prophecy and promise- looking closely at the special job Mary was asked to do, the birth of Jesus and the shepherds visit.</p>

<p>In music we will be following the Charanga units 1 and 2 which will help us to find the beat,</p> <p>In geography we will be learning to identify and locate the four UK countries, recognise and describe locations using basic compass directions. We will explore and describe seasonal changes and suggest appropriate clothing and activities for each season.</p> <p>In Art we will learn to name the primary colours, mix primary colours to make secondary colours. Make shades of a secondary colour.</p>	<p>P.E. is on a Monday afternoon with Year 1 adults and then on a Friday afternoon with Mr Lofthouse- please make sure your child has their kit, (including suitable footwear) in school.</p> <p>Please remove all jewellery.</p> <p>We will be looking at the 5 key skills of jumping, running, hopping, balancing and throwing as well as discovering new units from the P.E passport including our dance unit 'Toy Story' and then moving onto gymnastics.</p>	<p>The Year 1 team are available to answer any of your questions, celebrate your news from home or reassure you and your child should you have any worries.</p> <p>We will still be accessing continuous provision like EYFS so please ensure your child has a coat and expect that they may come home messy on some days if they have been learning outdoors.</p> <p><u>Reading Rainbow</u></p> <p>Children will be moving along the rainbow and gaining rewards along the way through reading regularly at home.</p>
