Attendance / Early Collection from School



Towards the end of last academic year, attendance at school for some children was poor. In this new academic year, we must make a determined effort to ensure that all of our children attend school regularly. Parents are asked **NOT** to book holidays during the school term as they will not be authorised and you risk a fine of £80 per parent. Parents who are not living with the family are also fined by Lancashire County Council. (Please see this year's term dates below).

Also, please could parents refrain from collecting children before home time (3:15pm) unless there is a genuine appointment which can be shown on an appointment card. Early pick-ups affect your child's learning and is disruptive to the

rest of the class. Once assembly has started on Friday, children will not be removed for early departure. Thank you.

Parent Governor

The governors are looking to welcome a new parent governor onto our governing body. Being a governor gives you a good insight into how a school runs and enables you to make a contribution and have your say in:

- Monitoring the quality of educational provision and the outcomes that children within the school achieve
- A focus on safeguarding
- A focus on special educational needs and supporting the most disadvantaged children.
- Having an involvement in shaping the future development of school

Being a governor means attending 3 full governor meetings over the school year and if you choose to be on a committee, up to 3-6 further meetings over the school year. You do not need to have any specific qualifications to be a school governor, just a passion for school improvement and for being part of the business aspect of school.

All jewellery must be removed for PE. School is no longer allowed to put tape over earrings as the guidance from Lancashire has changed. PE kits can be purchased from the Uniform and Leisurewear Shop in Lancaster.

School Uniform

Already in school we have had children misplace new school jumpers and cardigans. We realise that school uniform is not cheap and cannot constantly be replaced. PLEASE can I appeal to you to write your child's name in the label so we can return uniform. We have lots build up over the year that we cannot return because we do not know who owns them.

Breakfast and After School Club

Breakfast Club is available to parents from 7:40am in school. The cost per child is £3.50

After School Club runs from 3:15- 5:50pm every day at a cost of £7.00 per child.

All places can be booked via the school app or at the school office. Payments **must** be made upfront before the child attends.

Swimming

Our children in Key Stage Two (Y3-6) will take part in swimming lessons this year. Swimming is such an important life skill and we expect **ALL** children to participate as part of their PE curriculum. The timetable will be as follows:


